

## NOTES

- I. FRAME AND COVER SHALL BE CAST IRON CONFORMING TO SECTION 206-3 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- 2 2. WEIGHT OF FRAME SHALL BE 30 LBS. ± 5%. WEIGHT OF COVER SHALL 85 LBS ± 5%.
  - 3. A FOUNDRY MARK SHALL BE LOCATED ON THE BOTTOM OF THE COVER AND THE INSIDE OF THE FRAME.
- 4. FRAMES OR COVERS IMPORTED INTO THE UNITED STATES SHALL BE MARKED ON THE TOP SURFACE WITH THE ENGLISH NAME OF THE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN PRECEDED BY "MADE IN" BY MEANS OF CAST-IN-MOLD LETTERING. SUCH LETTERING SHALL BE I INCH HIGH WITH LINE WIDTH OF I/8 INCH ON THE TOP SURFACE OF THE UPPER PORTION OF THE FRAME WHICH REMAINS EXPOSED. ETCHING, DIE STAMPING, ENGRAVING OR WELDING ON OF LETTERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 5 THE PROOF-LOAD FOR TEST METHOD B, SUBSECTION 206-3.2 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS IS 28,600 POUNDS.
- 6. FOR THOSE MANHOLES OR STRUCTURES DESIGNATED AS PRIVATE ON THE PLANS OR SPECIFICATIONS THE THE WORD "PRIVATE" SHALL BE SUBSTITUTED FOR "CITY OF LOS ANGELES".
